RE: COVID-19 UPDATES

TO: All Roper Pump Company Employees

Counties surrounding Roper Pump Company have experienced a significant increase in positive COVID-19 cases. The Jackson County COVID-19 Community level has now risen to “high”, indicating that the CDC is recommending masks to be worn indoors in public.

We now advise anyone that is in close proximity (within 6ft) of others to wear a mask. The company will continue to provide masks, as we have in the past. Please see HR if you need one.

If you have been exposed to a positive COVID-19 case, please refer to the CDC website or contact Human Resources for guidance. If you have tested positive for COVID-19 or are experiencing even minor symptoms of COVID-19, do not come into work, and contact HR.

We will continue to monitor COVID-19 cases in our local communities and adjust the guidance as needed.
